

PROTECT YOUR HAY AGAINST THEFT

A new concept on hay theft prevention has just been announced by M.A. Mattos Enterprises of Patterson, California. Called "Operation Haywire" a method of quickly identifying individual baled hay is now available through the use of a special wire or twine. One strand of new rust-proof highly visible galvanized Baler Wire when used with regular wire will help identify individual hay quickly and easily and when used in combination with warning signs will help deter the theft of hay. This theft prevention program is available for both wire and twine users.

Galvanized wire can be used in any combination with regular wire using one or two strands. The Twine color selections are even greater with several colors to choose from with up to 24 combinations for more dramatic results. Each pallet of theft prevention wire or twine comes complete with four weather resistant warning signs and sign holders to be visibly placed at the stack stating -- "WARNING- This hay has been marked for easy identification in case of theft!" This should be an excellent deterrent especially in high theft areas, says Mike Mattos who heads the company.

A computerized user profile list for positive hay identification is also being developed and will be available on request. This is a dual purpose program that is designed to first prevent the theft through the use of highly visible wire and twine identification and warning signs-- and secondly, to make positive identification and the return of stolen hay quickly and easily.

Should an arrest be made on a hay theft suspect our computerized user profile information can be made available to help in the litigation process. This information can verify that in fact you were using a certain, galvanized and regular wire combination or a specific twine color combination adding more strength and creditability to your case. This would greatly increase your chances of claiming your stolen Hay. This can also serve as a means of identifying individual hay in the case of quality problems and disputes.
